Our instructors include music faculty from Northern Virginia Community College and area public schools.

The Camp Director is **Ms. Lisa Eckstein**. She is full-time faculty on the NOVA Alexandria campus, directs the Alexandria Band, plays the bassoon, and holds degrees from Indiana and Temple Universities. The Harp Camp Instructor is **Melissa Dvorak**. Melissa enjoys a vibrant and exciting career as a busy harp soloist, chamber musician, orchestral player and harp instructor in the DC area. She holds two degrees in Harp Performance from the Peabody Conservatory of Music, and completed additional studies at the Salzedo Summer Harp Colony. The Strings Camp will be led by **David McCormick**. David is a violinist and earned degrees in music education and performance from Shenandoah University and Case Western Reserve University. He is a co-founder of the early music group Three Notch'd Road (www.tnrbaroque.org) and has performed recently with the Duke Vespers Ensemble, The Columbian Consort (GWU faculty baroque ensemble), and the Chamber Music Society of Central Virginia. David currently teaches violin and viola in Charlottesville and for the Waynesboro Symphony Orchestra String School, where he also serves as ensemble conductor. The Extended Day Jazz Camp Instructor is **Mr. Kevin Pace**. Kevin is an accomplished string bass player and is an adjunct music professor on the NOVA Alexandria campus. He earned degrees from Elon University and the University of Maryland. He is a co-founder of the D.C. Jazz Composers Collective. **T.J. Agee** will help lead the Music Camp again in 2015. T.J. is an accomplished hornist and trumpeter, and teaches band and orchestra at Brentsville District High School in Prince William County, VA.

To ensure that you receive a space in the camp, please register quickly. Registrations are processed in the order in which they are received. Some popular instrumental areas in high demand will close.

Tuition for the week is \$375 prior to June 15th, and \$450 after June 15th. Payment is due at the time of application. There is a \$50.00 discount for a second sibling. After your application has been received and accepted, we will forward additional material to you. This will include when and where to come, how to park, what to bring, a map, and all other information needed to attend the camp. You will also be able to choose your classes for the week. Instrumentalists will need at least one year of experience on their instrument. The camp will be July 6 – 10 from 9:00 am – 3:30 pm in the Tyler Building of the Alexandria Campus. The final concert for family and friends will be held on July 10th at 2:00 p.m. on the Alexandria Campus in world-renowned Rachel M. Schlesinger Concert Hall and Arts Center.

For students participating in Music Camp, Extended-Day Jazz Camp is available from 3:30-5:00 Monday through Thursday. Extended-Day Tuition is \$125.

You may cancel your application for the music camp and receive a 75% refund only if the request is made at least two weeks prior to the opening of camp. No money will be refunded for any reason after the two week deadline. All instrumentalists except percussionists are responsible for bringing their own instruments. Percussionists must bring snare drum sticks and/or mallets. Students will need to bring a lunch every day to camp.

The faculty and staff of the NOVA summer music camp reserve the right to send home from camp any student who consistently exhibits unsuitable behavior or endangers the camp community, or whose actions towards others are unacceptable. The student's parent/guardian is responsible for picking the student up from camp.
